

## **ecoEnergy Retrofit program grants**



In Canada, the ecoENERGY Retrofit program is offered by the Office of Energy Efficiency (OEE) and allows you to obtain up to 375\$ for the replacement of your wood-burning appliance with a model that meets either *CSA-B415.1* or the *EPA 40 CFR Part 60* wood-burning appliance standard.

The term “EPA-certified” is commonly used in our industry jargon to designate an appliance that meets the *EPA 40 CFR Part 60* standard. The following Valcourt fireplaces are EPA-certified and therefore qualify under the program: model FP-8 (Saguenay), FP-9 (Versailles), and FP-10 (Lafayette).
