



## PEI OFFICE OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY UPGRADE LIST FOR GRANT PROGRAM

PEI's Office of Energy Efficiency offers a grant program applicable to the upgrade of various home equipments that include heating systems. Eligible dollar amounts cover material, labour, and all applicable taxes. Heating appliances purchased must meet certain requirements. Those requirements can be summarized as follows:

APPLIANCE TYPE	REQUIREMENTS
Wood stove, fireplace or insert	EPA certification
Pellet stove	Safety tested to CSA / ASTM1509
Wood furnace	Safety tested to CSA
Pellet furnace	Safety tested to CSA / ASTM1509

Grants offered under the program can be summarized as follows for each appliance type:

APPLIANCE TYPE	GRANTS
Wood stove, fireplace or insert	15% of total costs, up to 1,500\$
Pellet stove	15% of total costs, up to 1,500\$
Wood furnace	15% of total costs, up to 1,500\$
Pellet furnace	15% of total costs, up to 1,500\$

### Qualifying models:

The following Valcourt models qualify for the PEI's Efficiency NB's *Residential Energy Efficiency Program*:

#### High efficiency wood fireplaces

FP8 Saguenay  
FP9 Versailles  
FP10 Lafayette

### Important notes:

All applications must be approved by the Office of Energy Efficiency prior to any work commencing. An inspection prior to work starting and after work is complete will also be required. You will have 12 months to complete the upgrades.
